During a stay, guests are welcome to book an excursion to explore Lake Titicaca’s many artificial islands, with each one offering insight into the architectural expertise and weaving skills of the region’s Uro-Aymara communities, then head to nearby Taquile to bask in the beauty of the island’s traditional textile art.

After gaining some insight into the lives of Lake Titicaca’s local residents, guests can also come face-to-face with some of the region’s fascinating flora and fauna. For early risers, a birdwatching expedition is perfect for showcasing the incredible avifauna that calls the area home, with yellow-winged blackbirds, greater yellowlegs, and Titicaca grebes serving as just a few local residents, while afternoon rafting sessions are also available for guests, serving as the perfect opportunity for learning about the crucial role that the totora reed plays in both the surrounding ecosystem and in local cultural practices.

For Gastronomes: Cavas Wine Lodge
